PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Read this entire label and follow all directions and precautions.

USE RESTRICTIONS

小島 Bird Free may be used to deter feral pigeons, lesser black-backed gulls and other unwanted birds from roosting on buildings and other structures. 小島 Bird Free is supplied in ready-to-use covered plastic dishes. These should be affixed to surfaces with commercially available silicone adhesive (eg. Avisil), or other suitable adhesive. (See PREPARING SURFACES FOR TREATMENT and APPLICATION DIRECTIONS below.) Wear disposable gloves when using 小島 Bird Free.

PREPARING SURFACES FOR TREATMENT

To reduce potential exposure to bird-related diseases, wear waterproof gloves and appropriate PPE for dust protection when cleaning areas to be treated. Prepare surfaces to be treated by removing all nests, faecal matter and other debris, and thoroughly cleaning the surfaces. Take precautions to ensure bystanders and customers are not affected by this preparation activity. Using a suitable biocide or water mixed with detergent, wet surfaces where droppings are present to limit generation of airborne dust during cleaning. Allow cleaned surfaces to dry fully prior to treatment.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

Remove covers from ready-to-use plastic dishes and affix dishes to dry surfaces with silicone adhesive. For feral pigeons, dishes should be spaced (centre-to-centre) as follows: nesting sites 15cm; night roosts 20cm; day roosts 25cm. For spacing of dishes for other species of bird see INSTALLATION MANUAL at www.bird-free.com

STORAGE

Store in an area inaccessible to children and pets. Do not store near food or feed. Do not store in an environment which will corrode the plastic dishes.

DISPOSAL

Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of appropriately on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain. Ensure any exposed gel in dishes is covered to prevent spreading or contamination prior to disposal.

CLEAN-UP

When replacing, remove plastic dishes and clean surfaces with a disposable cloth soaked in soap and water. Wear appropriate skin and respiratory protection when performing these tasks. Remove the used dishes and treat them as controlled waste.
