ECOREX ACTION PLUS is an insecticide product for professional use against flying and crawling insects including flies, mosquitoes, moths, wasps, ants, cockroaches, earwigs, silverfish and other bristletails, fleas, bedbugs, beetles, spiders, mites, ticks and lice for use indoors and outdoors in domestic situations, commercial and industrial premises (including kitchens), amenity areas, hospitals (excluding occupied wards), military establishments, food storage and preparation areas, in and around farm buildings plus refuse disposal and waste storage areas.

Because of its special characteristics, ECOREX ACTION PLUS could be used indoors and outdoors.

ECOREX ACTION PLUS has an immediate and prolonged protective action lasting at least 3 weeks after application. Its special water-based formulation ensures an odorless product.

MODE OF USE:

Indoor treatment: Private houses, community residences, hospitals, barracks, bars, restaurants, hotels, cinemas, theaters, ships, warehouses, industrial facilities in general, including those in the food and beverage sector.

Outdoor treatment: Surrounding areas from houses and industrial plants, edges from roads and public parks, litter bins, etc.

If contact with eyes wash eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. In case of ingestion, do not provoke vomiting. Take the patient to hospital, and if possible, always take the label or container with you. NEVER LEAVE THE PERSON UNATTENDED.
