### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Add a small quantity of water to a suitable compression sprayer and then add product according to the table below. Add the remainder of the water, close the sprayer securely, shake to mix contents. Pressurise according to the sprayer manufacturer's instructions. One litre of ready-for-use spray treats 20 square metres of surface. Make up spray as required. Do not store spray overnight.

Apply as a low pressure spray. Some surfaces will absorb more spray, e.g. wall-paper, fabric or brickwork, but shiny surfaces can allow spray to 'run-off'.

**Crawling insects:** Spray around and behind fixtures and fittings or as a 'barrier' treatment around doors and windows, paying special attention to cracks and crevices and where pests are seen to harbour.

**Flying insects:** Apply to areas and surfaces where flying pests are seen to rest. Do not use Vulcan C against houseflies in intensive or controlled environment animal houses as this may provoke insecticide resistance.

To avoid risks to man and the environment, comply with the instructions for use. This product is approved under The Control of Pesticide Regulations 1986 (as amended) for use as directed.

#### STATUTORY CONDITIONS RELATING TO USE - INSECTICIDE FOR PROFESSIONAL USE ONLY

The (COSHH) Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations 1999 may apply to the use of this product at work. Maximum dose, 100 ml per 5 litres water per 100 square metres sprayable surface. Engineering control of operator exposure must be used where reasonably practicable in addition to the following items of personal protective equipment:

### PRECAUTIONS
