BIO-RID SANITISER & CLEANER

Bio-Rid is used to control the disease organisms associated with pest birds (i.e. Pigeons, Starlings, Sparrows, Gulls etc). It is intended to be used in areas where persons may come into contact with bird droppings, feathers, nesting materials and where birds nest or roost.

This product will kill bacteria, fungi protozoa, rickettsiales and viral organisms associated with birds which are related to diseases which can be transferred by pest birds to humans or other animals. This product is designed to protect workers whose work includes clean-up and removal of bird droppings.

Deposits considered to be hazardous to health and defined as "statutory nuisances" under the Environmental Protection Act 1990 Part III need to be treated to remove the risk to other persons or animals who might be affected by contractor activities.

Bio-Rid can also be used for the treatment of Weils Disease and the Canine Parvovirus.

Directions for use:

General Biocide:

Dilute 100ml per 5 litres of clean water and apply by coarse spray, mop or wipe. This should be applied to surfaces on which birds are known to land, nest or roost to protect workers operating on such surfaces

Removal of Droppings:

Dilute 100ml per 5 litres of clean water and apply to droppings by coarse spray prior to clean-up operations. When digging out, spray each exposed layer to keep down dust and kill organisms. For dead birds, collected nests and other materials dilute 100ml with 1 litre of water and treat.

Treatment of Equipment:

Dilute 100ml per 5 litres of clean water to clean equipment such as PPE; e.g. boots, gloves, face protection & tools.

Contains:

8% Benzalkonium Chloride, <2% EDTA

Precautions:

Causes severe skin burns and eye damage. Causes serious eye damage. Very toxic to aquatic life with long lasting effects.

If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand. Keep out of reach of children. Read label before use. Do not breathe vapours. Wash with soap and water thoroughly after handling. Contaminated clothing should not be allowed out the work place. Avoid release to the environment. Wear protective gloves/protective clothing/eye or face protection. IF SWALLOWED: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. IF ON SKIN (or hair): Remove/take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/shower. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and keep at rest in position comfortable for breathing. Store locked up. IF IN EYES: Rinse continuously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do so. Continue rinsing. Immediately call a POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician. Specific treatment (Section 4 of MSDS Sheet) Wash contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Collect spillage. Dispose of contents/container in accordance with all local, regional, national and international regulations. Safety data sheet available on request.
